Personal Equipment Checklist

The following is a list of material to be provided by each participant:

- Weather appropriate clothing
 - Must not be too big and baggy
 - Must not be too small so as to restrict body movement
- NO belts!!!
- Rain gear
- Tennis Shoes or hiking boots (nothing with cleats)
- Water bottle
- Lunch
- Camera
- Sunglasses
- Notebook and pen/pencil
- *Participant Hold Harmless & Release Agreement* form with all signatures and information
- *Parental Hold Harmless & Release Agreement* form with all signatures and information (ONLY IF PARTICIPANT IS UNDER 18)
- *Medical Information & Informed Consent* form with all signatures and information

NOTE:

- NO jewelry is allowed (necklaces, bracelets, rings, earrings, watches)
- Leave wallets and other pocket stuffers behind
- Bring any emergency medication that you have (epi-pen, etc)
