DUAL DEGREE status is needed if you wish to pursue two degrees in two different departments/programs. Dual Degree applicants should obtain special instructions at the Graduate Program Office(s), the Graduate Academic Records and Dissertations Office, or the Graduate Admissions Office.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS approved for a change of Program, or Change of Degree Level must provide the following documentation in order to receive a new SEVIS I-20.

- Copy of current I-20
- Copy of your funding letter, if you will be funded by your program
